Product Description:

Exploros is a real-time interactive educational platform. It is designed for teachers, students, and administrators, where each has a different feature set. The platform hosts a variety of curriculum programs. The responses below indicate platform capabilities and are specific to Exploros-authored curriculum programs, including Exploros Social Studies and English Language Arts. Third-party curriculum providers who utilize the platform have the same platform accessibility features available. However, since each program has the ability to ingest custom content, the report may vary slightly based on the curriculum program being reviewed.

Evaluation Methods Used:

Testing used Chrome v135. Exploros supports the current versions of Chrome and Safari. Teacher and student experiences were evaluated; the administrative experience was not evaluated.
