

READING ACCELERATOR

A key instructional strategy in *Reading Accelerator* is marking up words. Students analyze new words by underlining, linking, circling, and boxing letters and letter combinations. When students learn to identify and mark learned graphemes in words, they gain agency and control over the decoding process. As students advance through the skill sequence, the mark-up scaffolding can be reduced to focus on the newest skills being taught.

The following pages contain examples of the mark-ups used in each lesson, including some of the words students will code and read in the Student Workbook as part of Lesson A. Marking up the words is not an exact science, but employing the strategy will assist students in decoding, using syllabication generalizations and set for variability.



Underline individual vowels.



Draw a swoop under digraphs, special combinations, *r*-controlled vowel teams, and consonant clusters.



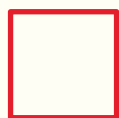
Draw a circle around vowel teams (except *r*-controlled).



Draw a vertical line between syllables.



Cross out silent *e* and draw an arrow from the *e*, over the consonant, pointing to the working vowel.



Draw a box around affixes.
